c. Dental Coordinator-*Greg Wise*

- February is National Children's Dental Health Month so starting to plan and gear up for that. Trying to get more providers to volunteer their time and/or clinic for that event coming up the first week of February.
- Overwhelmingly positive feedback about the clinic from area dentists. They are getting a lot of calls from people who have state insurance that are seeking a dental provider. This clinic will certainly help a lot of people.
- \$990,000 total was raised to help with furnishings and things like that.
- A conversation about interpreters and language services has started.

d. COVID Vaccine Update-*Jacob Anson*

- The Pfizer vaccine for 5 to 11-year-olds was approved last week. Due to its approval, we are working to provide 3 clinics to the community, one being in Buffalo, one in Monticello and another in Delano. Currently there are still a few spots available in Monticello and Delano. You can find more information on our COVID-19 page on the Wright County website. Otherwise MDH has a new website, <https://mn.gov/vaxforkids> that allows you to locate vaccines throughout the state.
- Question: How many 5 to 11-year-old vaccine clinics are there in Wright County?
 - (a) Allina is doing one. Most of them are happening outside of county. Wright County Public Health will be doing their first one this week at the Hwy Department as a drive through. The other two will be next week at the schools in Monticello and Delano.
- Question: Is there somewhere in Wright County that parents can call if their child would have an adverse side effect?
 - (a) They can call Wright County Public Health and they will follow through with the VAERS reporting. Otherwise, there is also V-Safe that you can report through there.
